I wonder why the hair on our heads keeps growing...

Hair grows by forming new cells at the root of each hair. As these new cells form, the old ones are pushed out of the opening in your scalp, called hair follicles and die. As more cells die, your hair grows.

I wonder why sweets make your teeth fall out...

Sweets attract bacteria. Bacteria cause cavities, which are holes in teeth. Cavities cause your teeth to rot, and this makes your teeth fall out. We brush our teeth to help stop sweets from making our teeth rot.

I wonder some people have curly hair while others have straight hair...

We all have holes in our scalps called follicles, which come in different shapes. Some are round. Some are oval. And some are narrow and long. If your hair is straight, your follicles are round. If your hair is a little curly, your follicles are oval. If your hair is very curly, your follicles are narrow and long. If you looked at your hair through a microscope, you would see that your type of hair matches your hair follicles. You cannot permanently change the type of hair you have, it will always stay the same.
