I wonder what sound is...

Sounds are vibrations that move through the air. When you clap your hands or stamp your feet, vibrations or sound waves travel out in big circles like ripples in a puddle when a stone is thrown into it. You have vocal cords in your throat that vibrate and make sounds when you talk or sing.

I wonder why we get dizzy when we spin around...

Some people think that your ears only do one job- hear. But your ears also help you keep your balance. There is liquid in your ears and when you spin around, the liquid swirls around, too. The swirling liquid stimulates tiny hairs in your ears. The hairs send messages to the brain, telling it that you are spinning, the liquid still swirls around and tells your brain that you dizzy for a while after you stop spinning.
