I wonder what the difference between crocodiles and alligators is...

A crocodile has a long nose while an alligator's nose is short and wide. You can see some of a crocodile's teeth when it shuts its mouth, but when an alligator shuts its mouth, you cannot see any teeth. A crocodile is longer than an alligator.

I wonder how frogs breathe in the water...

Frogs can breathe through their skin or through their lungs. In water, the oxygen in the water goes right through their skin and into their blood, so frogs can stay in water for a long time without having to come up for air. On land they can breathe through their lungs like humans.

I wonder how sharks breathe in water...

Water enters the shark's mouth and leaves through the gills. The gills filter the oxygen out as the water passes through. That is how sharks get oxygen underwater.
